

Government funded programs explained



Circles of Support – Youth (COSY)

- A Queensland Government funded youth support service helping 8-21 year olds experiencing social, emotional or behaviour difficulties that impact their wellbeing and relationships.
- Operates in Nambour, Gympie and surrounding Sunshine Coast hinterland regions.

Disability Employment Services (DES)

- Funded by the Australian Government to partner with people with disability, injury or health condition and tailor assistance to prepare for, find and keep a job.

jobactive

- jobactive provides eligible job seekers with access to tailored assistance, based on their assessed needs. CSG partners with job seekers to achieve and maintain their employment goals.

New Business Assistance with New Enterprise Incentive Scheme (NEIS)

- Supports turning a business idea into a viable business, through accredited small business training, business plan development, business mentoring and NEIS allowance.

National Disability Coordination Officer (NDCO) program

- Funded by the Australian Government Department of Education, Skills and Employment.
- NDCOs work collaboratively to ensure equitable access to tertiary education, training and subsequent employment opportunities for people with disability.

ParentsNext

- Funded by the Australian Government to support eligible parents and carers to plan and prepare for work by the time their youngest child starts school.

School Leaver Employment Support (SLES)

- Supporting school leavers who are NDIS-funded achieve their goals, by discovering what kind of job they want, building their job ready skills or getting work experience.

Skilling Queenslanders for Work (SQW)

- Funded by the Queensland Government, SQW provides accredited training and employment support for eligible participants seeking employment.

Transition to Work

- Provides intensive pre-employment support for young people aged 15-24 years to obtain employment, connect with education and local community services.
