

#teampossible Workplace Giving Frequently Asked Questions

Q. I already give my time, why would I also donate from my pay?

A. This is an optional scheme and there is no requirement to donate. The scheme is an opportunity for those who do wish to give to do so from their pre-tax pay – maximizing what Endeavour Foundation receives but minimising what comes out of take-home pay.

Q. The NDIS funds supports for people with disability, what would donations be used for?

A. The impact of giving contributes towards the things the NDIS doesn't cover such as virtual reality kits to support vital skills development and furnishings to turn a house into a home.

Q. I already give elsewhere, why would I give to Endeavour Foundation?

A. It is **entirely optional to donate from your pre-tax pay**. External studies have shown that many employees in Australia actively seek a workplace giving scheme and see it as a benefit to them – it's a way to donate to a cause while also reducing their taxable income.

Q. How will I know how funds are being used?

A. The #teampossible Workplace Giving scheme has been refreshed. Part of that refreshment involves keeping donors up-to-date on how funds are being used.
