Information about your board



Rent is money you pay to live in an Endeavour Foundation house.

You pay rent every two weeks.



Board is money you pay us to get your food, pay your electricity bills, and buy groceries.

You pay board every two weeks.



Not everyone pays board.

Ask your support worker if you pay board or not.

Information about your board



If you are **over 21** and pay board, you will start paying more board from **07 November 2024**.



You will pay **\$524.40 in board** every two weeks.



If you are **under 21** and pay board, you will not have to pay more board.

It will stay the same



You do not need to do anything. We will do everything for you.

Information about your board



You already receive the money you need to pay board.

You do not have to go and get more money to pay your board.



Why is my board going up?

If you are over 21 years old, the government has increased the amount you get in your Disability Support Pension.

This means the amount you pay for board increases too.



If you are 21 years old or younger, the government has **not** increased the amount you get in your Disability Support Pension.

This means the amount you pay for board will not increase.

Information about your board



The government made a rule that your rent can only go up once a year.

Your rent will not go up again until next year.
