Set up Windows Hello

Windows Hello is a quick, personal and secure way log into your Windows 11 device.

Select *Start > Settings > Accounts > Sign-in options*

Under '**Ways to sign in**' you'll see 3 choices to sign in with Windows Hello.

Follow the prompts to set up your preferred option.



Sign-in with facial recognition



Sign-in with a fingerprint reader.



Sign-in with a PIN.

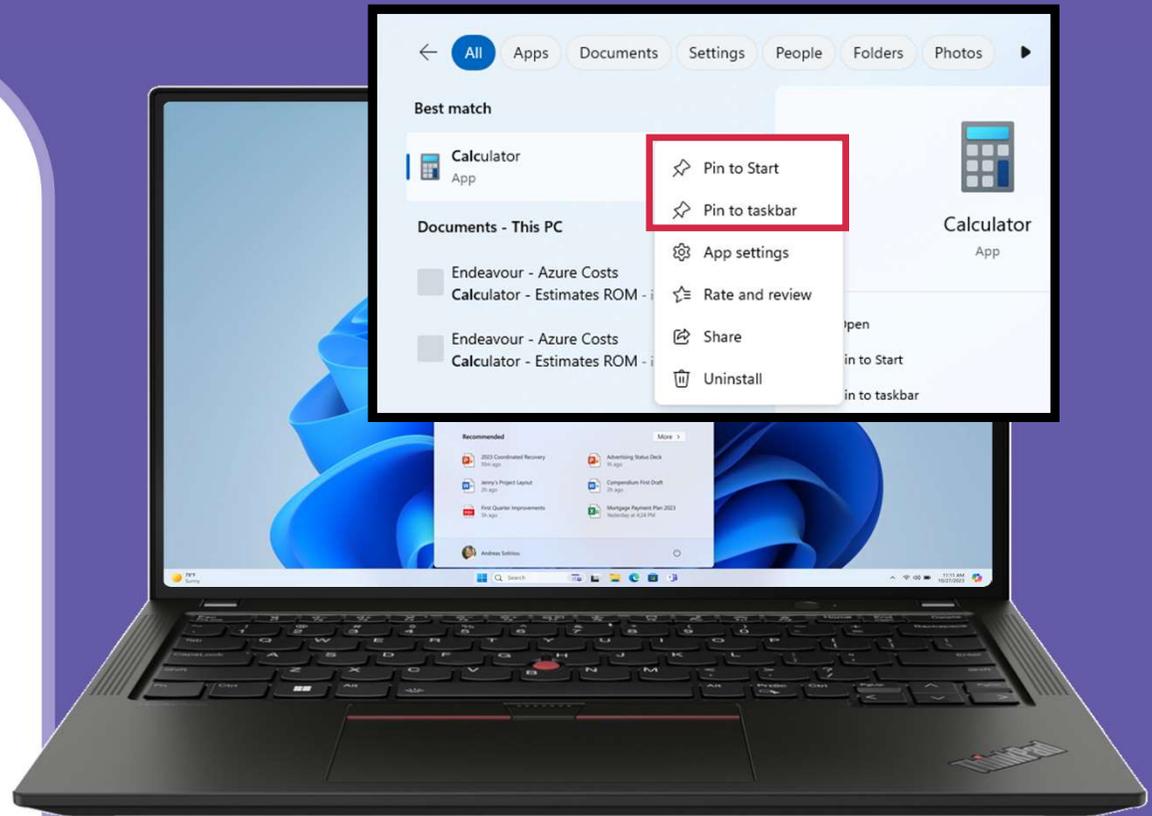

Pin your apps

Easily pin files, folders or applications to your **Start** menu or **Taskbar** for quick and easy access

1. Open the **Start** menu.
2. Locate the file, folder or app you want to pin.
3. Right-click on the app.
4. Select the **Pin to Start** option to pin to your start menu
5. Select **Pin to Taskbar** to pin to your taskbar

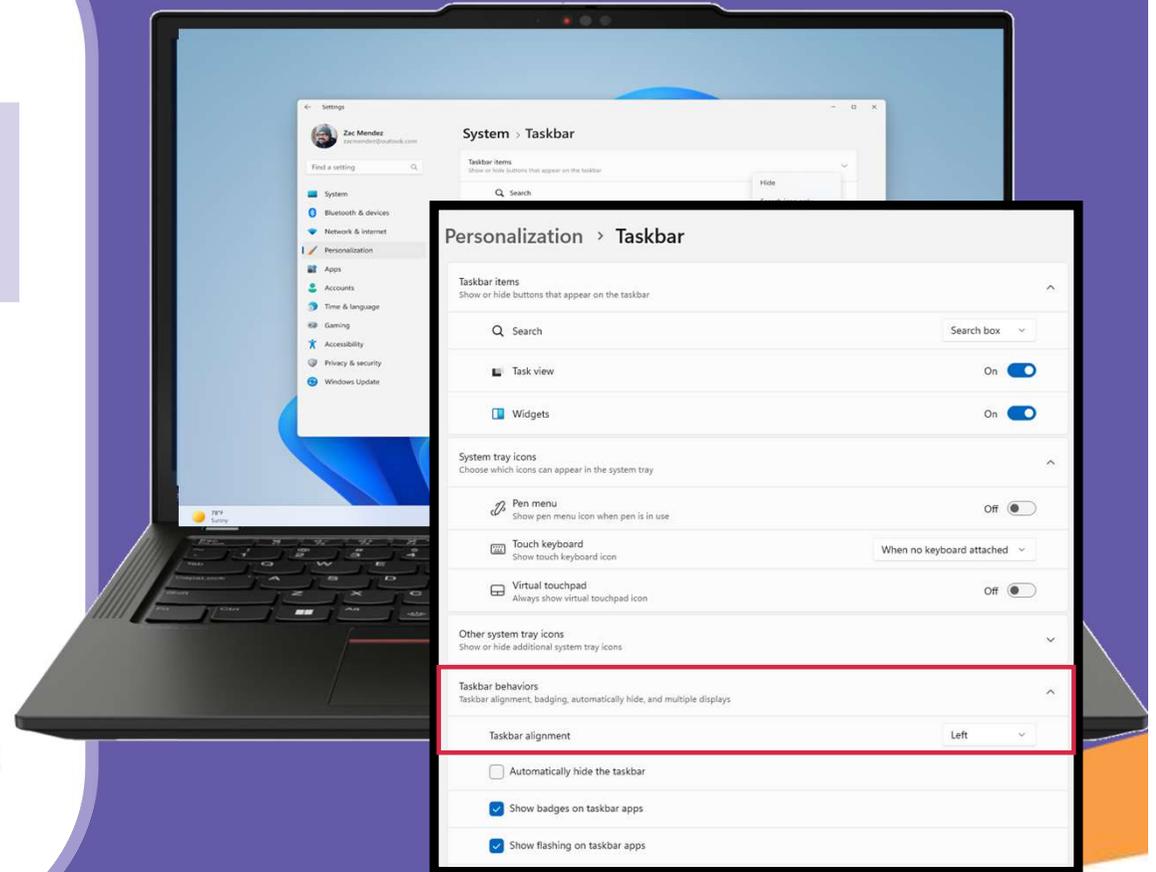


Taskbar Settings

The taskbar allows you to quickly access your favorite apps.

Prefer to have your start menu back on the left?

1. Right click any empty space on the taskbar, and then select '**Taskbar settings**'
2. Scroll down to '**Taskbar behaviors**'
3. Select '**left**' from the drop down option
4. Close the window



Share from the taskbar

Sharing your screen just got easier!

In Microsoft Teams, you can easily share a window when in a meeting or on a call, straight from your taskbar.

Simply select the open window and click **Share**.



File Explorer

Just like opening tabs in a web browser, File Explorer lets you open or add new tabs.

Easily switch between File Explorer tabs, re-arrange opened tabs, and scroll the tab list. You can even copy files and folders between tabs.

You can also add files to favorites and view them on the File Explorer home screen, and easily find files and share with the right contacts in File Explorer.

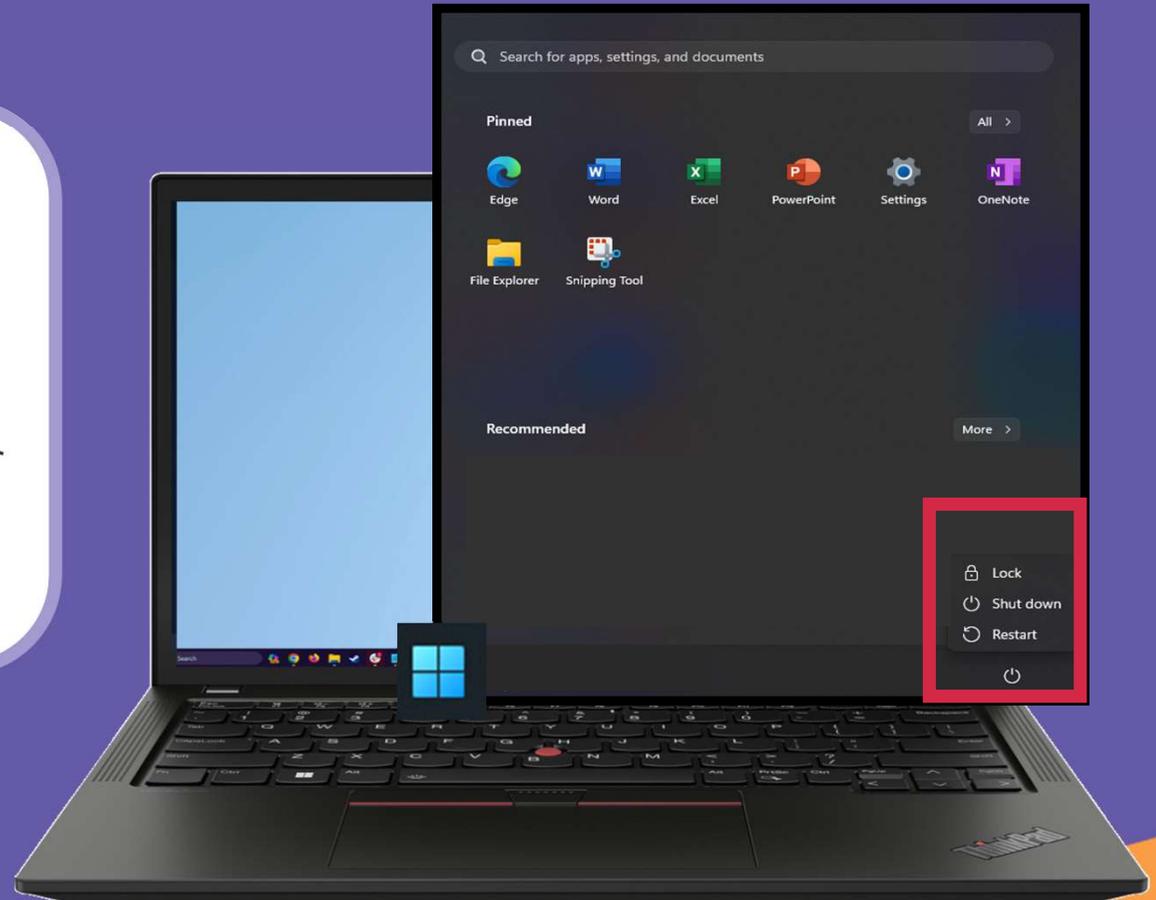

Power off & Restart

Finished what you're working on?

Lock, turn off or restart your computer by clicking on the windows icon and the power icon as shown here:





OneDrive

Sync files between your computer and the cloud so that you can access your files from anywhere!

You can work with your synced files directly in File Explorer and access your files even when you're offline.

When you are online, any changes that you or others make will synchronise automatically.

Set up OneDrive by typing "OneDrive" into the search bar.

Outlook

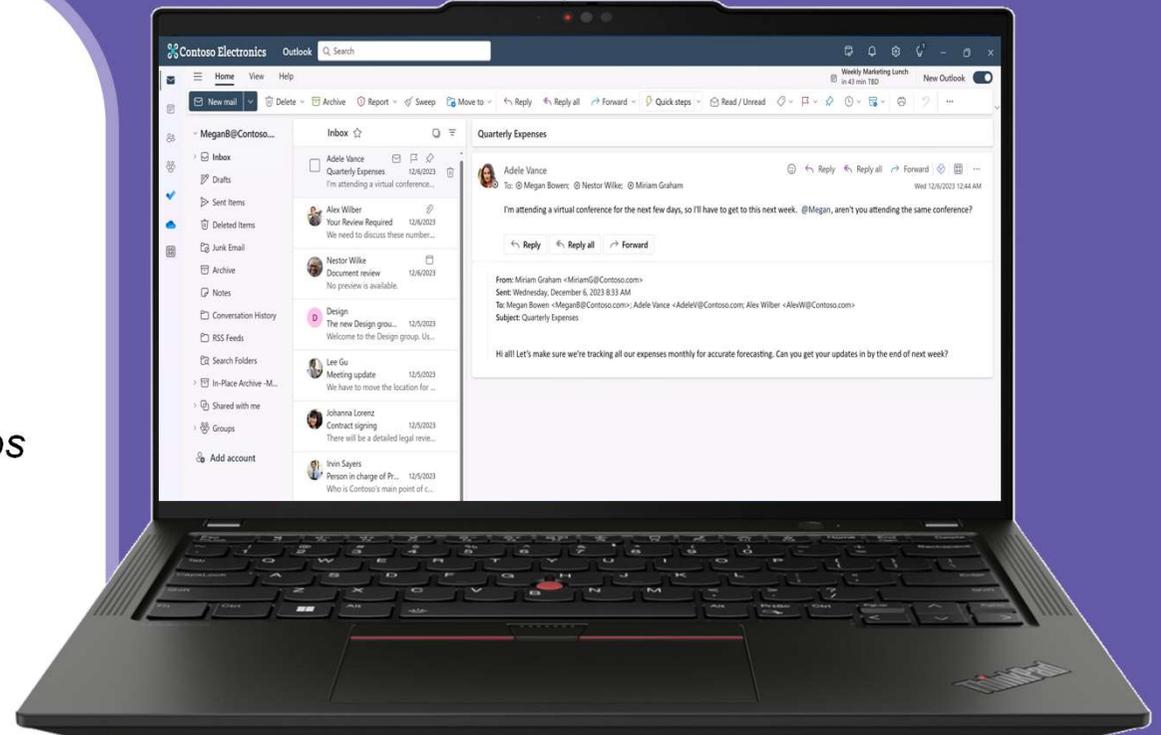
The new look outlook brings the latest features and a modern simplified look.

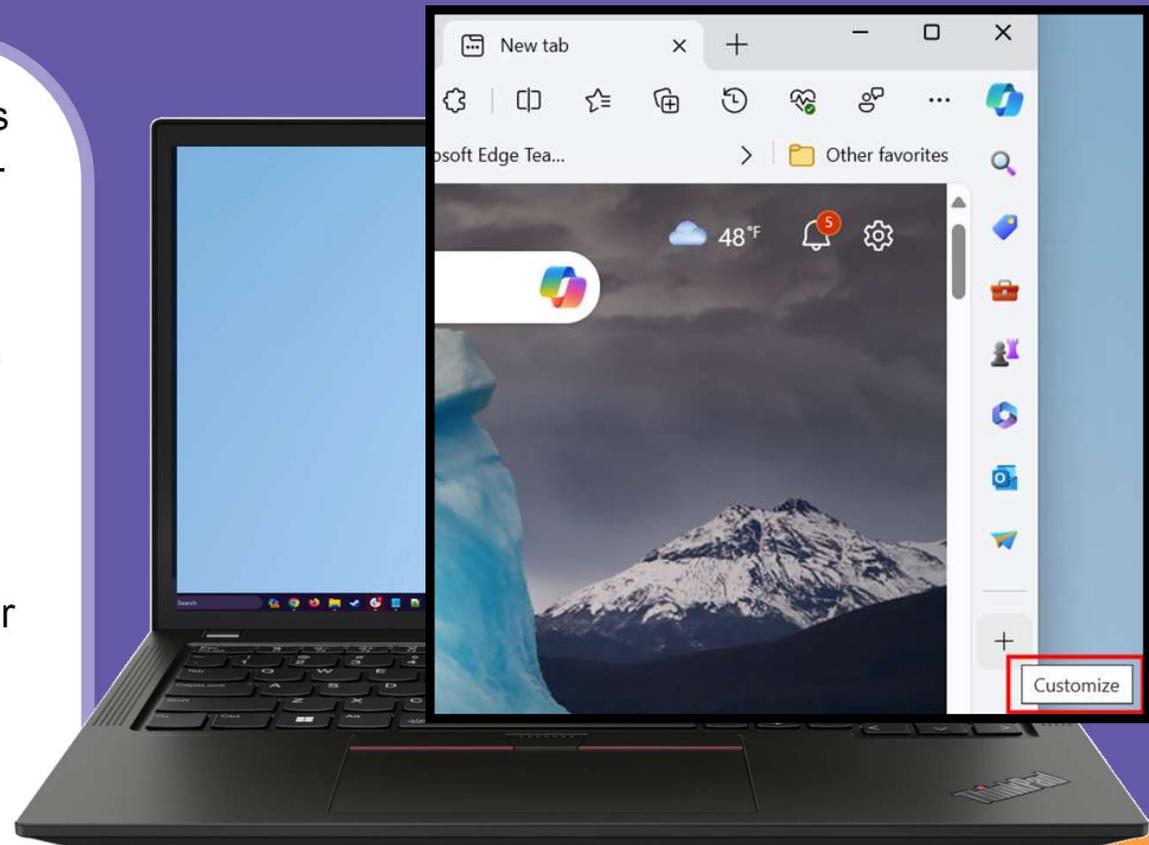
Multitasking in Edge

From being able to search specifically within the page you're viewing, to using tools for quick help without navigating away.

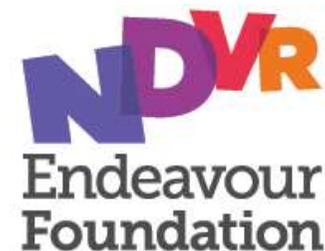

Adjust for light and color sensitivity with [Dark and Contrast themes](#).

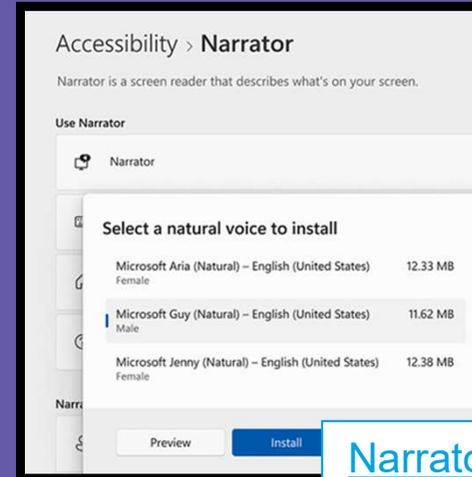

Enhanced Clipboard

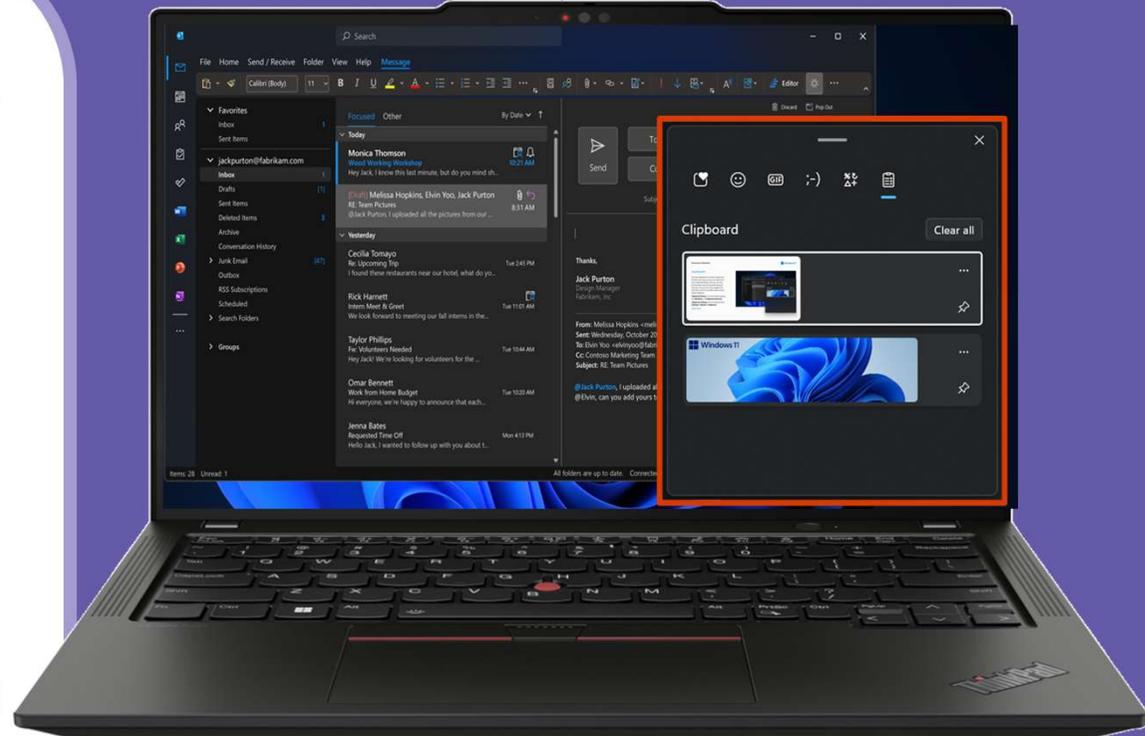
The new Clipboard means you can paste from your clipboard history, but you can also pin the items you find yourself using all the time.

You can also copy images and text from one PC to another with a cloud-based clipboard.

Clipboard history can be found by typing the 'Windows + V' keyboard shortcut.

Clipboard settings can be accessed from *Settings* → *System* → *Clipboard*

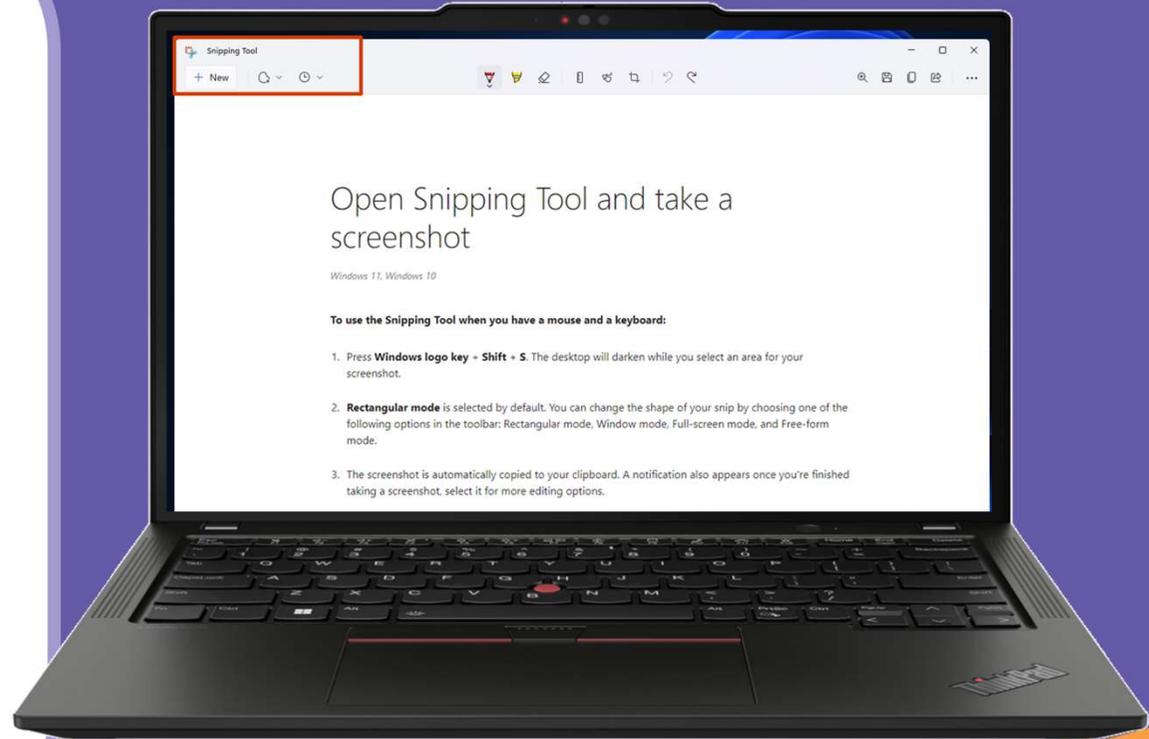
New Snipping Tool

The Snipping Tool is great for capturing and editing screenshots and now includes screen recording!

The image or video can be a selected area, the full screen or a freeform shape.

You can even take a delayed screenshot for items that require you to click first

The Snipping Tool can be found by typing 'Snip' into Windows Search or with the '**Windows + Shift + S**' keyboard shortcut.
